

How to Close the Doors for the “Spirit of Amalek” over Israel and the Nations with Your Prayer



Dear Friends,

In the book of Revelation 3:7, we read a promise for our prayer that we can apply with authority: “And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write: ‘The words of the holy one, the true one, who has the key of David, who opens and no one will shut, who shuts and no one opens!’ We can open and shut spiritual doors in prayer with the ‘key of David’. David obviously heard the voice of heaven and together with the Lord he calls out to us in Psalm 110: “Rule in the midst of your enemies!” (v1) Let us rise up resolutely in prayer and stretch out the “sceptre of his power” from Zion! You can use the following ten prayer points to do this.

1. Israel – You are a Light to the Nations!

Prayer: Give thanks for the calling of Israel for the nations!

Is 49:6 (ESV): I will make you as a light for the nations, that my salvation may reach to the end of the earth.

2. Israel – You have a Priestly Calling!

Prayer: We give thanks for our mandate to pray with 1Peter 2:9.

Exodus 19:5-6 (ESV): ⁵ Now therefore, if you will indeed obey my voice and keep my covenant, you shall be my treasured possession among all peoples, for all the earth is mine; ⁶ and you shall be to me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.

3. Israel – You are the Firstborn Son among the Nations!

Prayer: We humble ourselves and repent of the envy and jealousy of the nations over the calling of Israel!

Exodus 4:22 (ESV): And you shall say to Pharaoh, “Thus says the LORD: Israel is my firstborn son!”

4. Israel – You are Destined to be a Blessing to all the Families of the Earth!

Prayer: We humble ourselves and repent for despising and rejecting the blessing of Israel in the nations.

Genesis 12:3 (ESV): In you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.

5. Israel – but Jesus Christ conquered sin, death and the devil on the cross of Calvary in Jerusalem!

Prayer: We thank Jesus for the cross and proclaim the power of the blood of Jesus in the visible and the invisible realm!

Col 2:15 (ESV): He disarmed the rulers and authorities and put them to open shame, by triumphing over them in him.

6. Israel – The Son of David will return and reign as King from Zion over all the ends of the earth!

Prayer: We proclaim that the Lord has stretched out the scepter of His authority over the nations and the spirit of Amalek has been defeated and is under His feet!

Ps 110:1-2 (ESV): The Lord says to my Lord: “Sit at my right hand, until I make your enemies your footstool.” The Lord sends forth from Zion your mighty scepter. Rule in the midst of your enemies!

7. Israel – You are loved and chosen!

Prayer: We close the spiritual doors for the spirit of Amalek, which denies the election of Israel and manifests in the spirit of unbelief, atheism and randomness: The God of Israel is alive, has a plan, and He reigns!

Isaiah 41:8-11 (ESV): ⁸ But you, Israel, my servant, Jacob, whom I have chosen, the offspring of Abraham, my friend; ⁹ you whom I took from the ends of the earth, and called from its farthest corners, saying to you, "You are my servant, I have chosen you and not cast you off"; ¹⁰ fear not, for I am with you; be not dismayed, for I am your God; I will strengthen you, I will help you, I will uphold you with my righteous right hand. ¹¹ Behold, all who are incensed against you shall be put to shame and confounded; those who strive against you shall be as nothing and shall perish.

8. Israel – You are beautiful, a jewel in the hand of God!

Prayer: We close the spiritual doors to the spirit of Amalek that defiles and pollutes Israel. We proclaim the beauty of Israel in the eyes of God!

Isaiah 62:3 (ESV): You shall be a crown of beauty in the hand of the Lord, and a royal diadem in the hand of your God.

Zechariah 3:3-5.9 (ESV): ³ Now Joshua was standing before the angel, clothed with filthy garments. ⁴ And the angel said to those who were standing before him, "Remove the filthy garments from him." And to him he said, "Behold, I have taken your iniquity away from you, and I will clothe you with pure vestments." ⁵ And I said, "Let them put a clean turban on his head." So they put a clean turban on his head and clothed him with garments. And the angel of the Lord was standing by. ⁹ ... I will remove the iniquity of this land in a single day.

Zechariah 9:13-14.16 (ESV): For I have bent Judah as my bow; I have made Ephraim its arrow. I will stir up your sons, O Zion, against your sons, O Greece, and wield you like a warrior's sword. ¹⁴ Then the Lord will appear over them, and his arrow will go forth like lightning; the Lord God will sound the trumpet and will march forth in the whirlwinds of the south.. (...) ¹⁶ On that day the Lord their God will save them, as the flock of his people; for like the jewels of a crown they shall shine on his land.

9. Israel – Your God fights for you!

Prayer: Pray against Amalek's attack on the divine splendor of Israel's invincibility: Let us proclaim new victory and protection over Israel!

Isaiah 54:14-17 (ESV): ¹⁴ In righteousness you shall be established; you shall be far from oppression, for you shall not fear; and from terror, for it shall not come near you. ¹⁵ If anyone stirs up strife, it is not from me; whoever stirs up strife with you shall fall because of you. ¹⁶ Behold, I have created the smith who blows the fire of coals and produces a weapon for its purpose. I have also created the ravager to destroy. ¹⁷ No weapon that is fashioned against you shall succeed, and you shall refute every tongue that rises against you in judgment. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord and their vindication from me, declares the Lord.

10. Israel – It is time to return to the living God!

Prayer for a spirit of humility, prayer and national repentance! The Lord wants to restore, reconcile and heal Israel!

2 Chr 7:14-16 (ESV): ¹⁴ If my people who are called by my name humble themselves, and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land. ¹⁵ Now my eyes will be open and my ears attentive to the prayer that is made in this place. ¹⁶ For now I have chosen and consecrated this house that my name may be there forever. My eyes and my heart will be there for all time.
