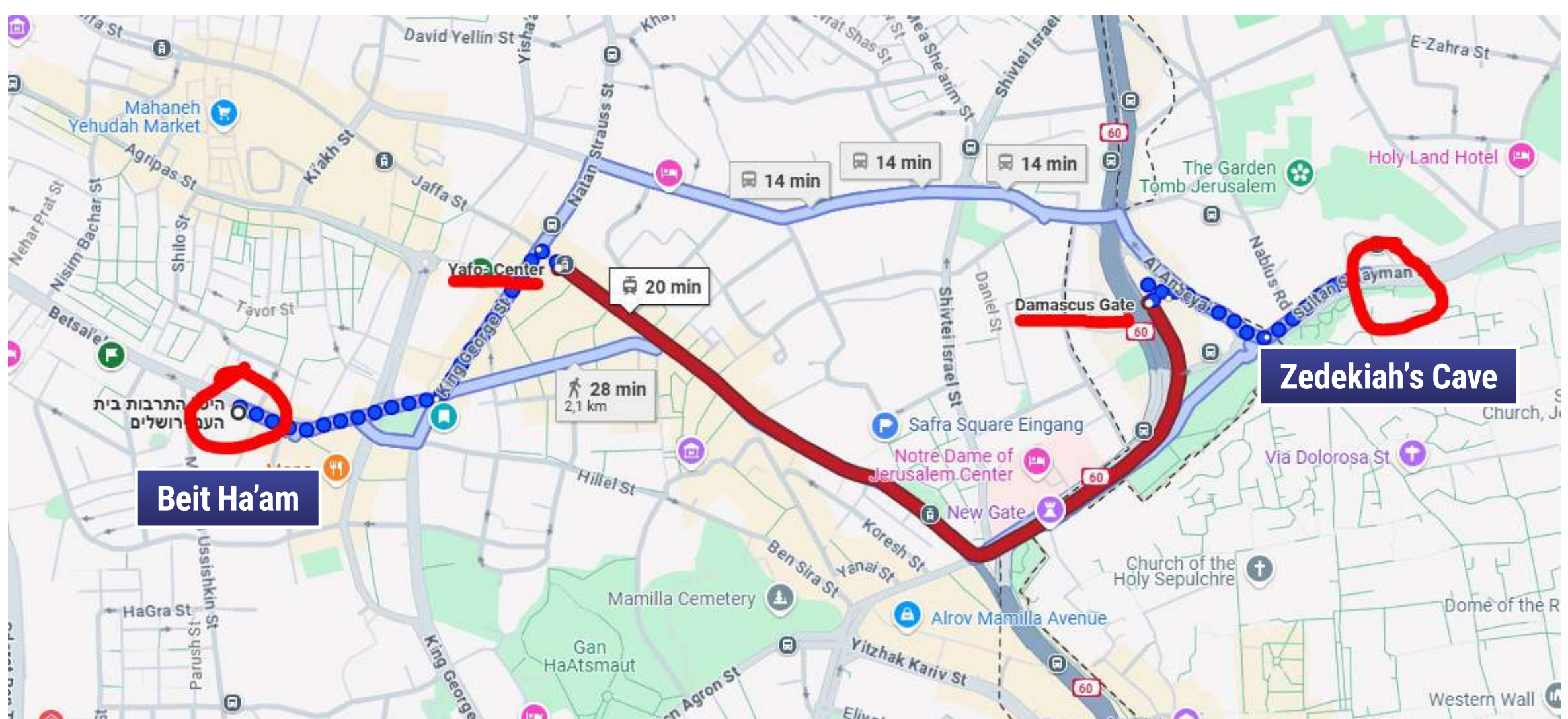

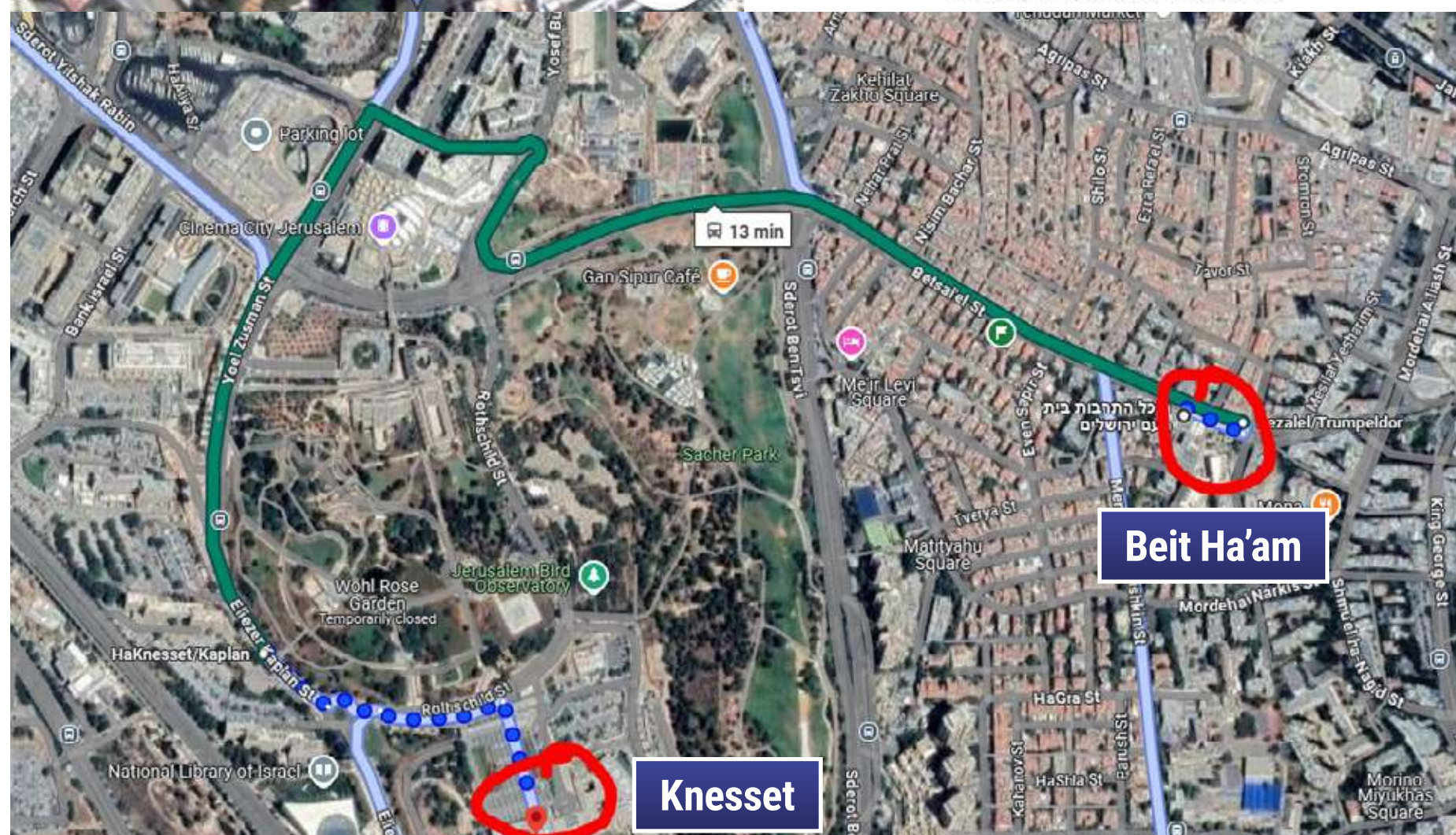
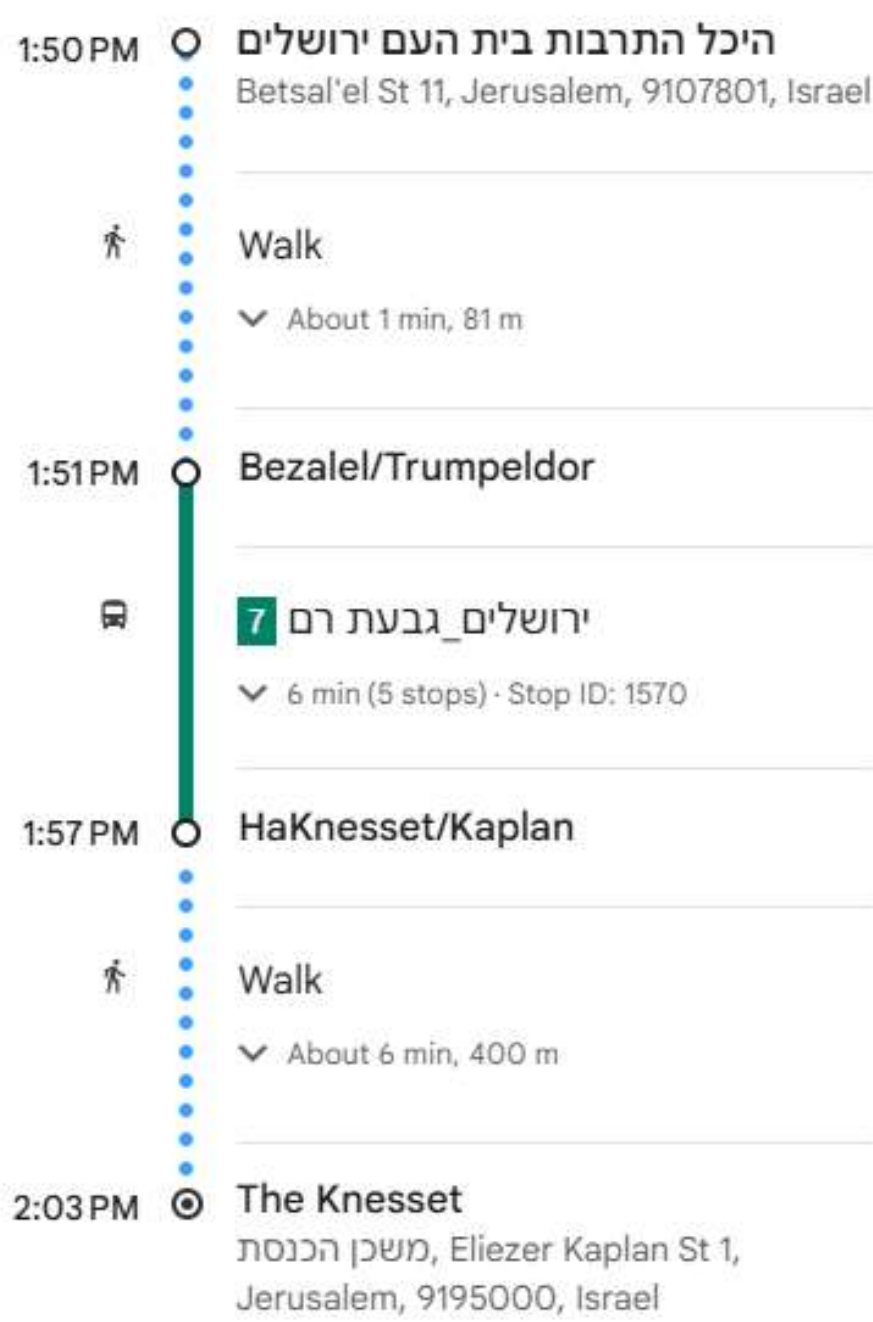
How to get to Zedekiah's Cave

1. Leave Beit Ha'am and walk east on Bezalel Street.
2. Turn left onto King George Street and continue walking until you reach the Davidka Square light rail station on Jaffa Street. (Approximately a 10-minute walk.)
3. Take the train going in the direction of "Heil Ha'Avir".
4. Ride 3 stops and get off at "Damascus Gate/Shar Shechem".
5. Walk for about 5 minutes:
 - Cross the street toward the Old City wall
 - Walk left, past Damascus Gate
 - After about 200 meters, you will see the entrance to Zedekiah's Cave on your left.



How to get to the Knesset

1. Leave the venue Beit Ha'am and walk to the Bezalel/Trumpeldor bus stop, located just across Bezalel Street.
2. Then, take one of the following bus lines:
 - Line 7
 - Line 9
 - Line 66
3. The ride takes about 10 minutes.
Get off at the "Knesset" stop.



How to buy a Ticket for the Light Rail/Bus

Single ride tickets

- **Light Rail:** Vending machines are available at all stops
- **Bus:** Payment on the bus is only possible electronically – cash is not accepted.

Rav-Kav Card

(a rechargeable travel card for buses and trains)

- Available at ticket machines, train stations, Light Rail stops and many supermarkets

Mobile Apps such as

(use your credit card)

- HopOn
- Moovit
- Rav-Kav Online

With these apps, you can easily purchase a ticket and scan the QR code when boarding the bus.

Jobst Bittner

is the founder and president of the March of Life Movement, which has mobilized thousands people worldwide onto the streets against antisemitism and for Israel in recent years.

Eran Massas

is a former Israeli lieutenant colonel who became a hero for his selfless actions during the October 7 Hamas attack, when he responded to the Supernova music festival massacre and worked tirelessly to aid survivors.



Suzette Hattingh

is the founder of “Voice in the City” and preaches the message of Jesus Christ and His transformative power that can still be experienced today to tens of thousands of people. Her ministry, accompanied by many signs and wonders, has taken her as far as Southeast Asia.

Ilan Dalal

is the father of Guy Gilboa-Dalal, a 24-year-old Israeli who was abducted from the Nova Festival by Hamas on October 7, 2023. Since then, Guy has been held captive in the Hamas terror tunnels in Gaza.

is a Holocaust survivor born in 1937 who, as a child, hid in the sewer tunnels of Nazi-occupied Warsaw and survived as a hidden child. She later became a professor at the Hebrew University in Jerusalem.
